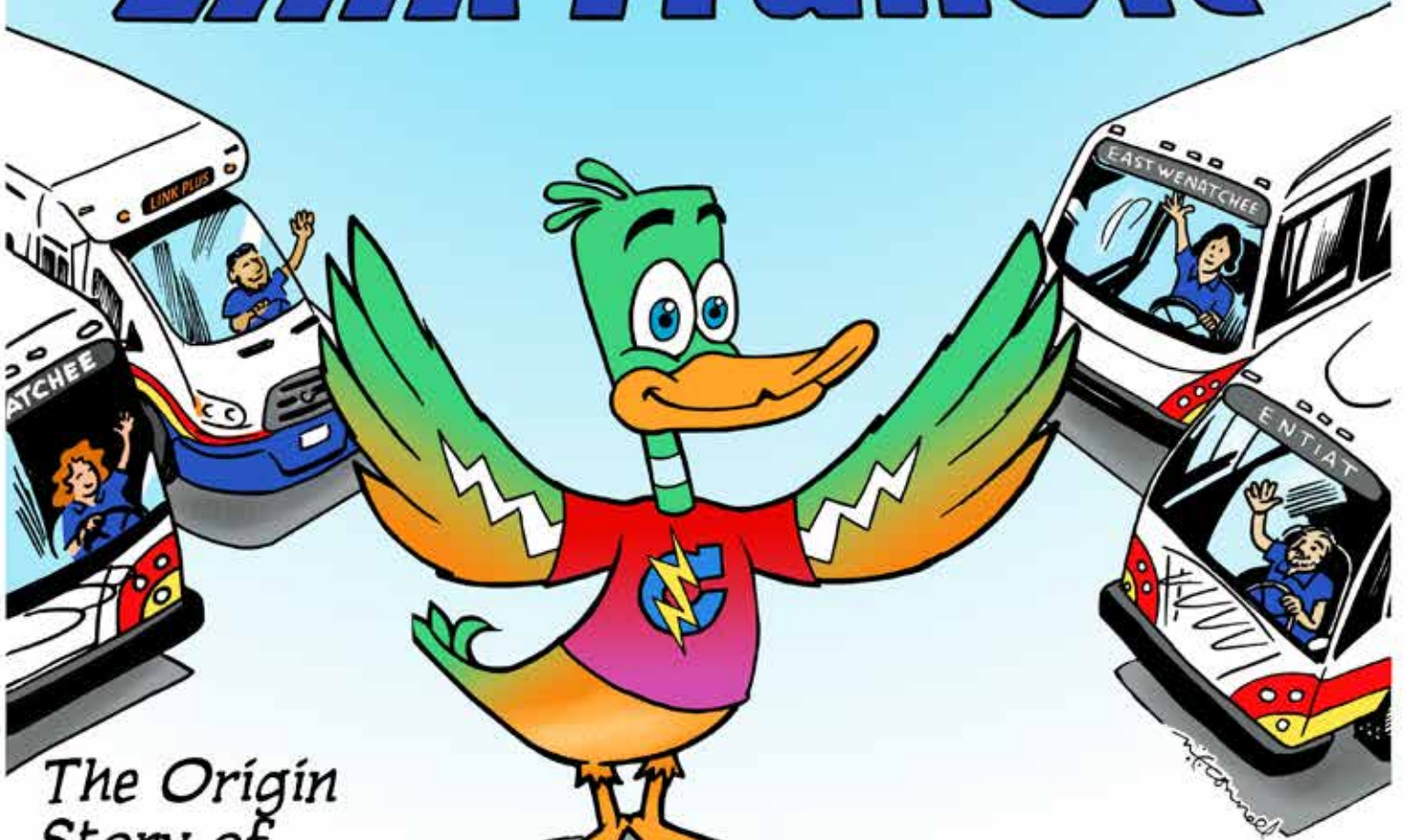

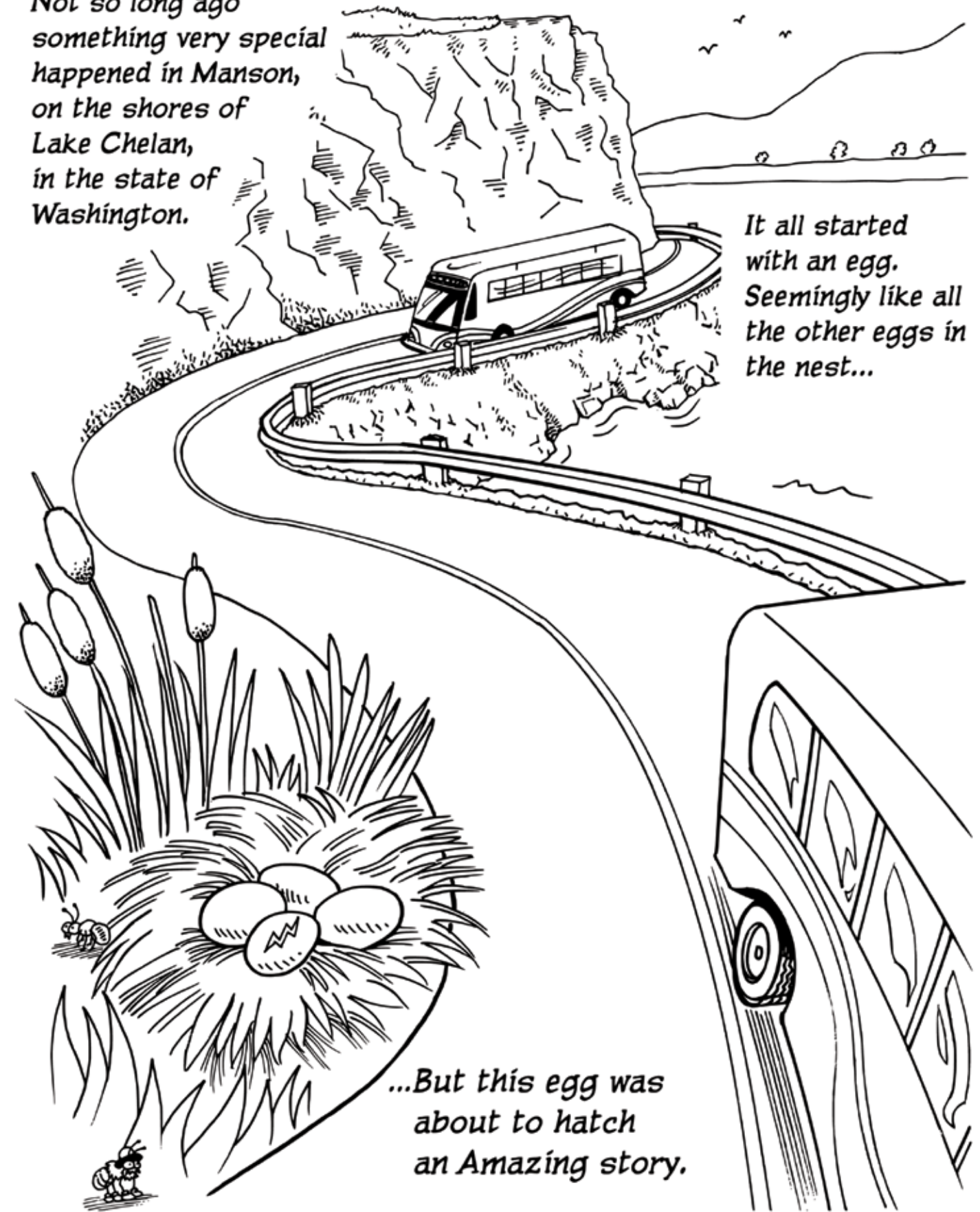
The Origin

the nest...

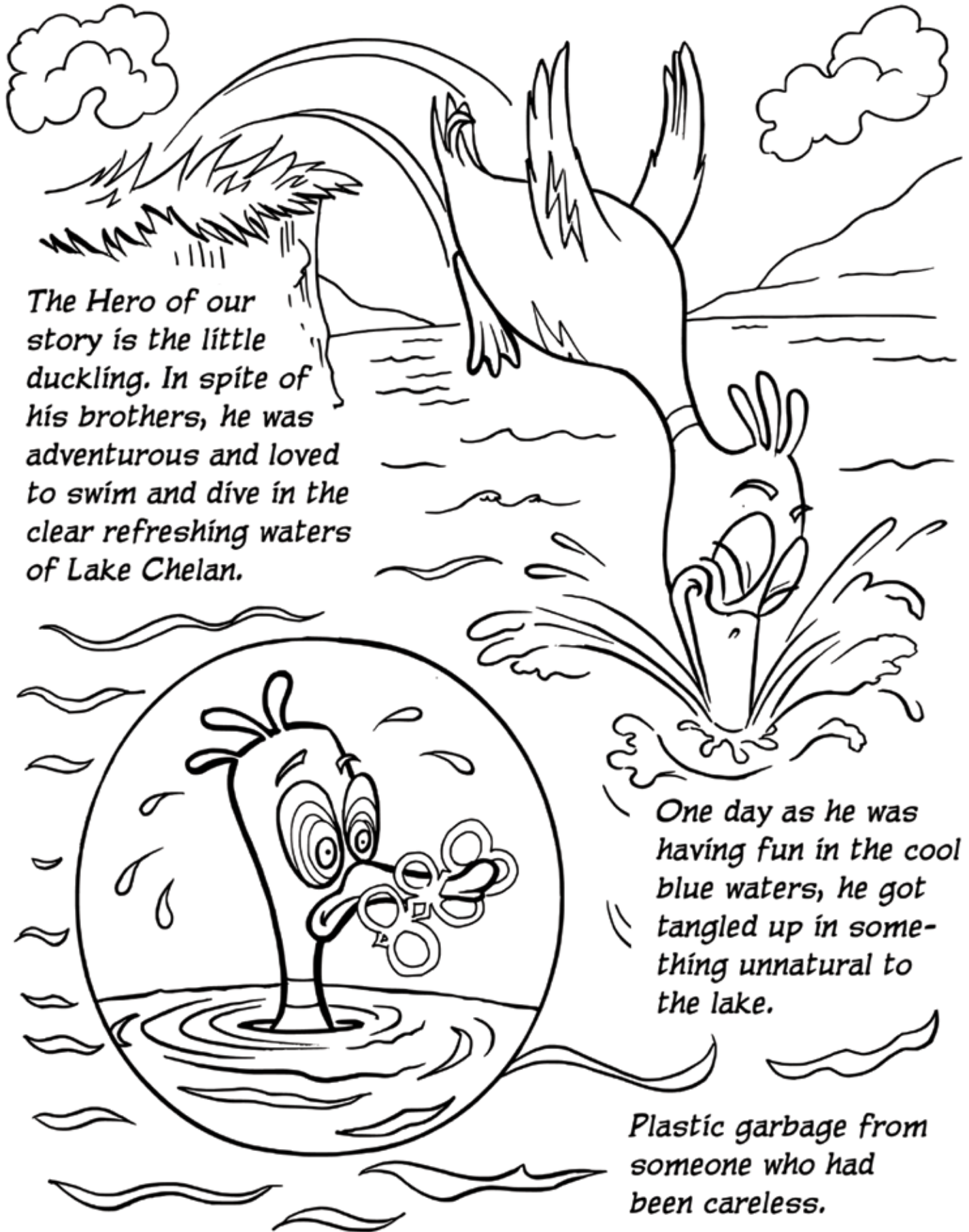
...But this egg was

bullied the little one.



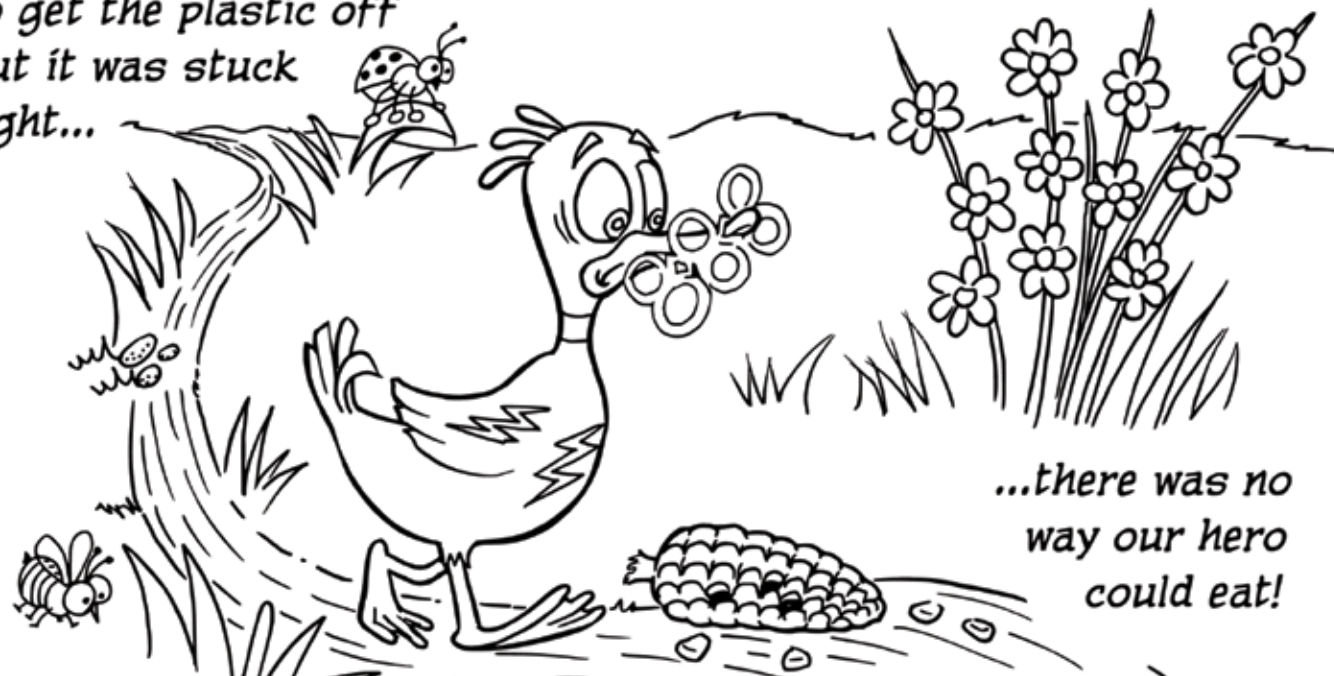


The Hero of our story is the little duckling. In spite of his brothers, he was adventurous and loved to swim and dive in the clear refreshing waters of Lake Chelan.

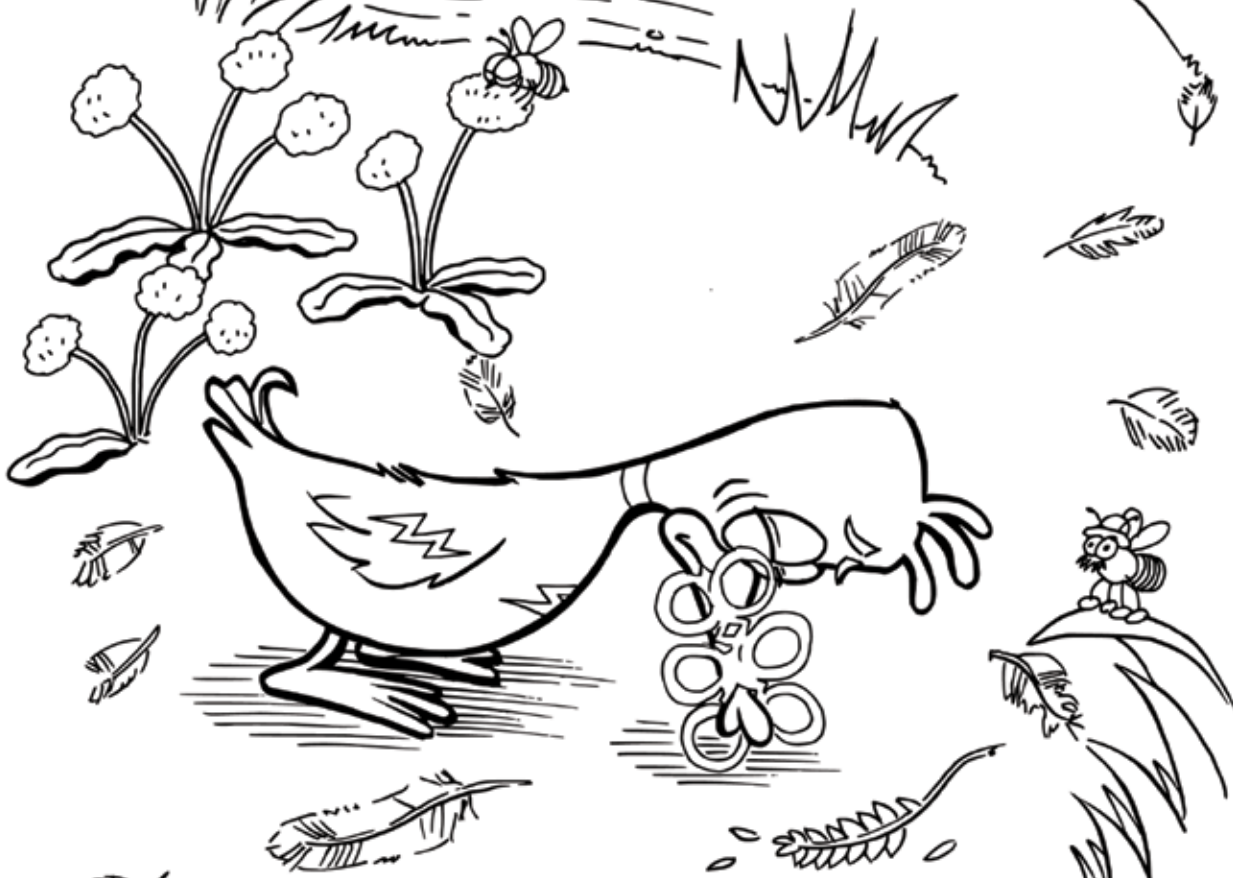
One day as he was having fun in the cool blue waters, he got tangled up in something unnatural to the lake.

smaller.

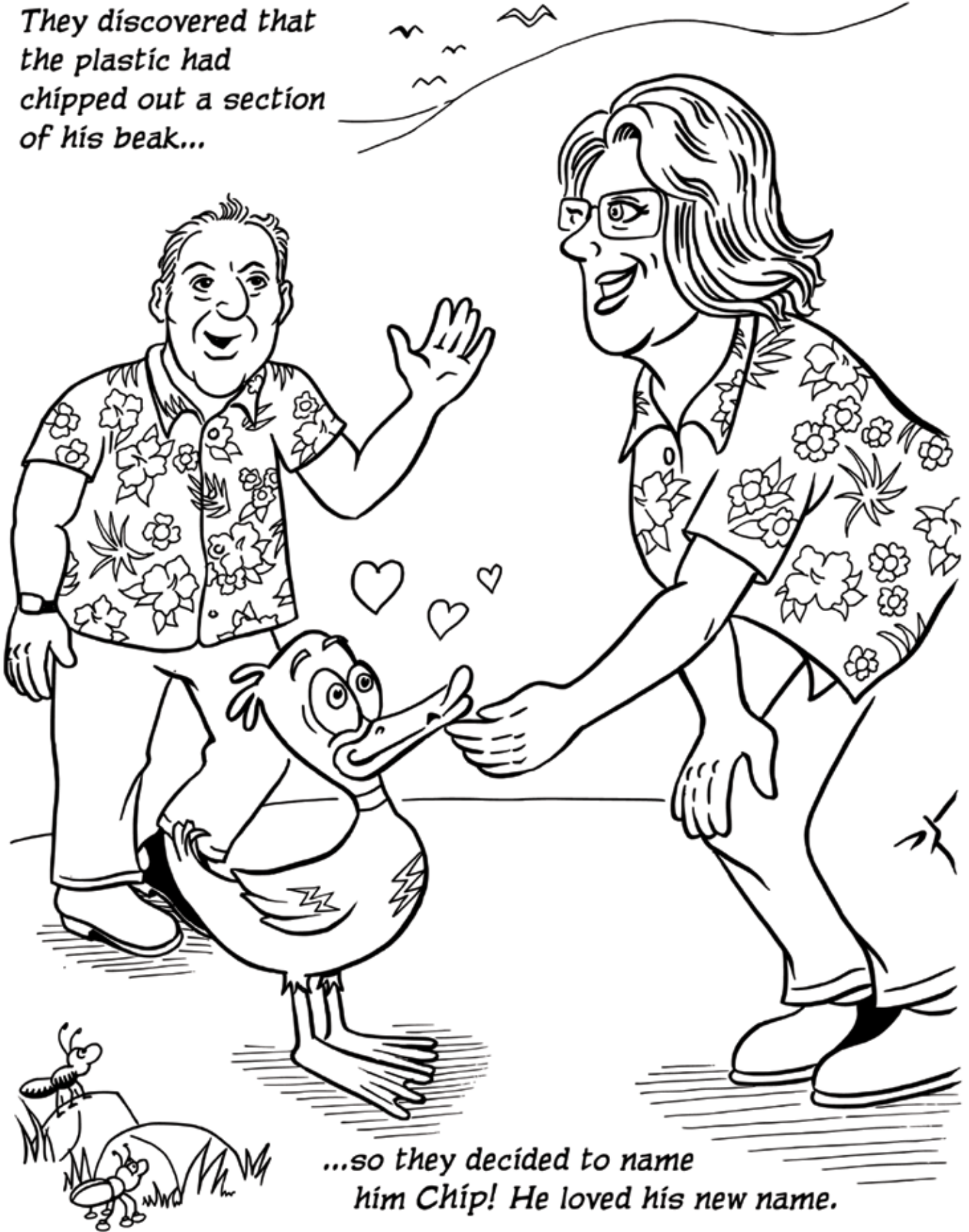
One day some

STARVING

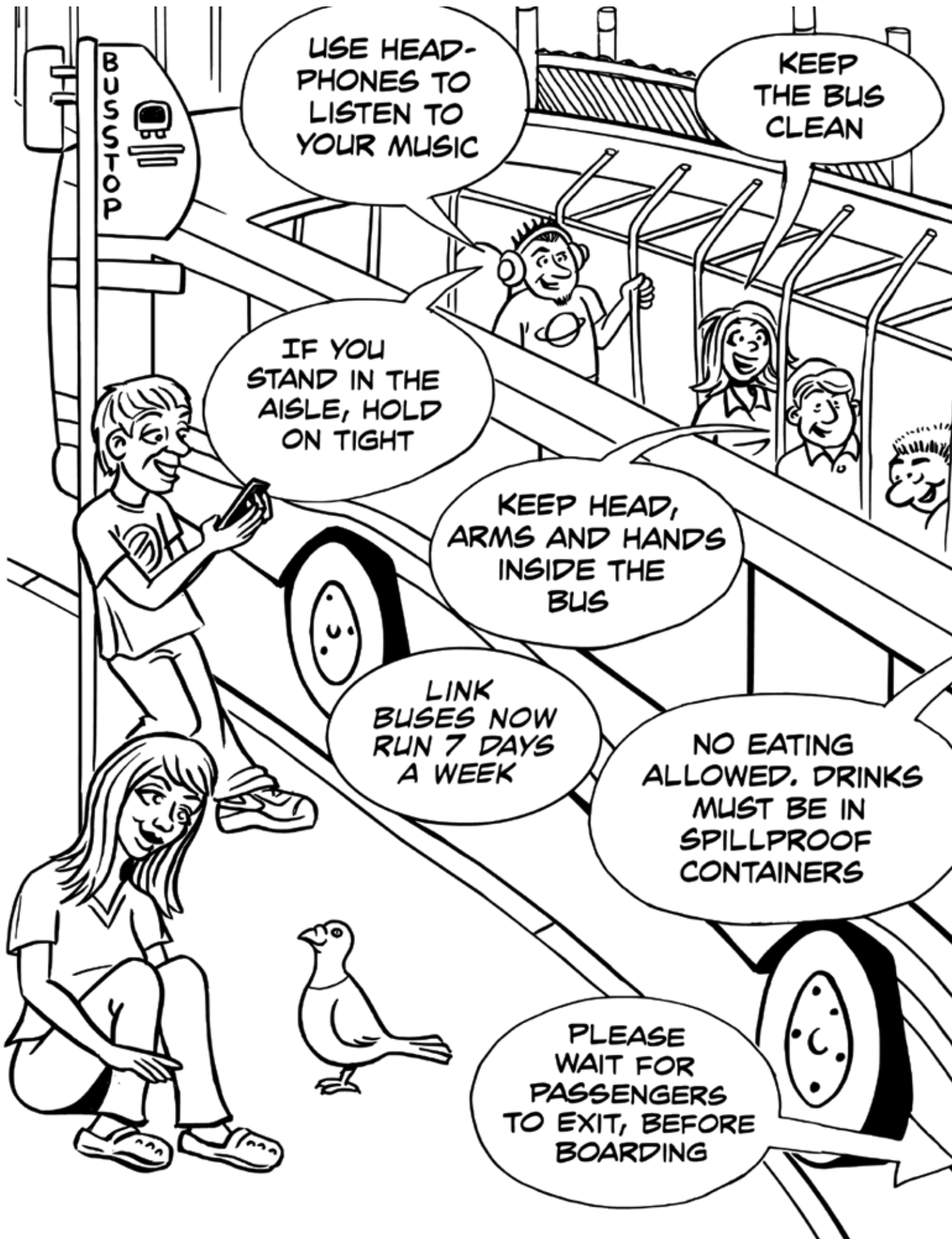


They snipped off

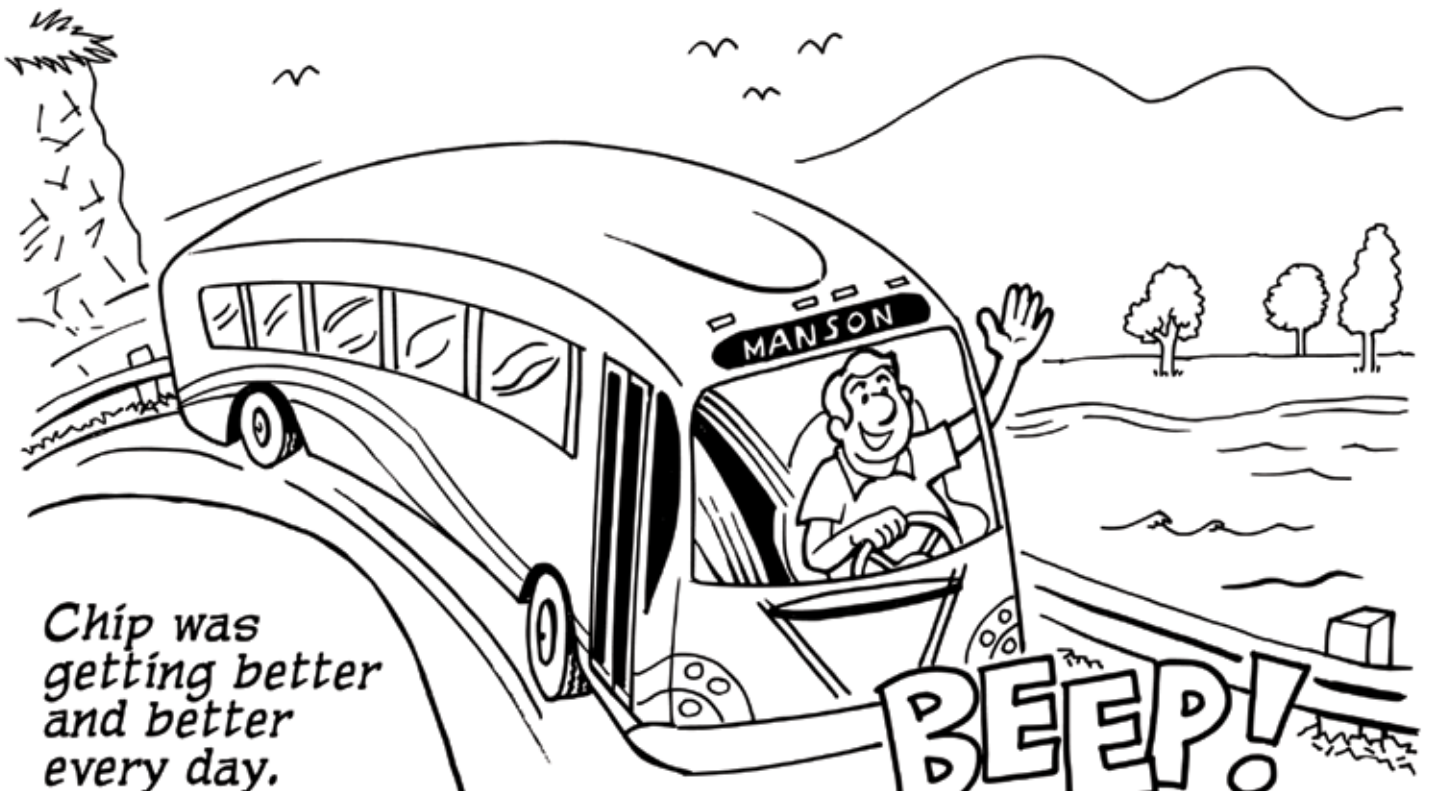
...Meanwhile, back in Wenatchee, Link Transit was establishing the rules.



TALK QUIETLY

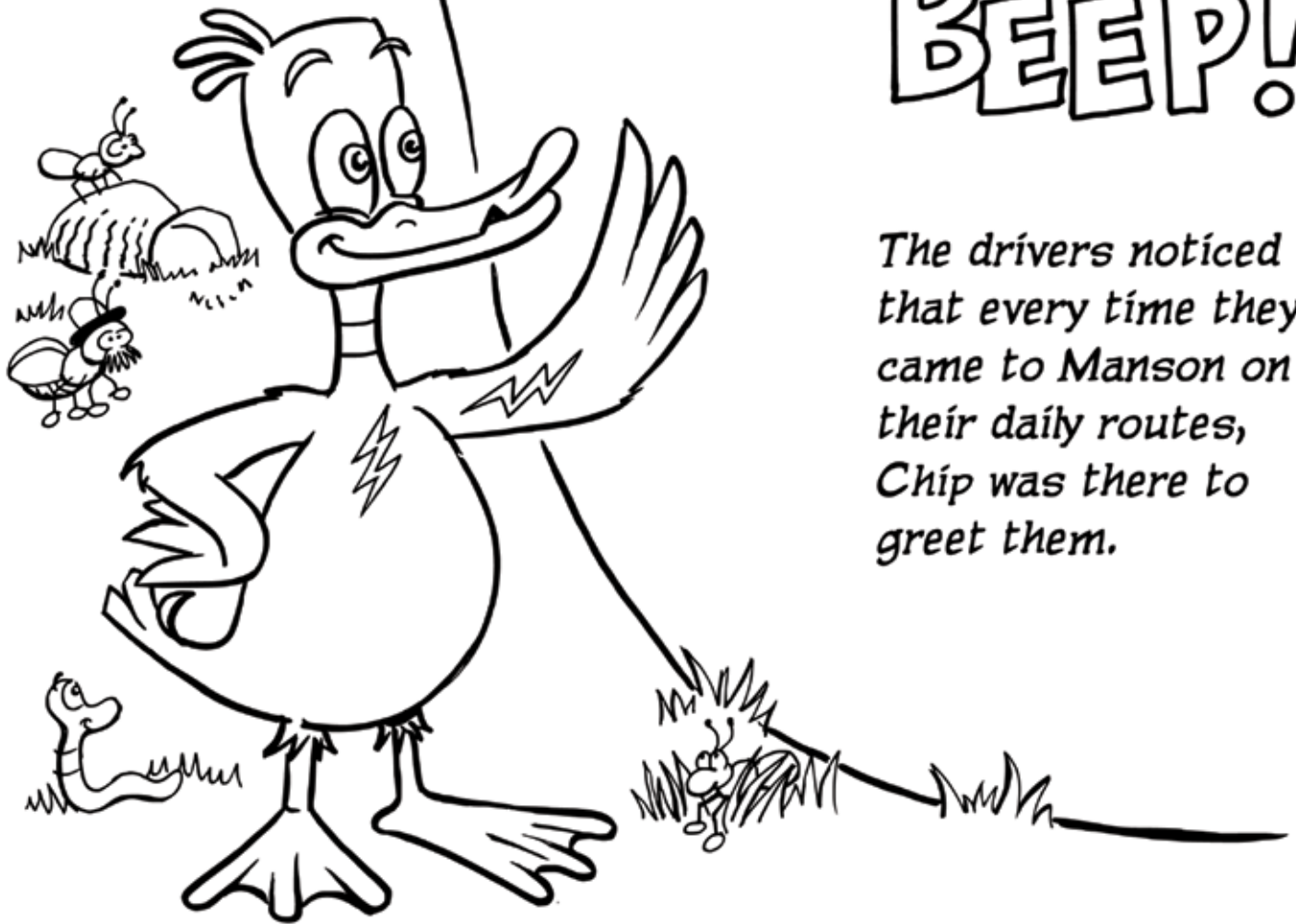
SEATS IN THE FRONT ARE FOR SENIORS AND DISABLED PERSONS

...and were proud of the confident young duck he had become.

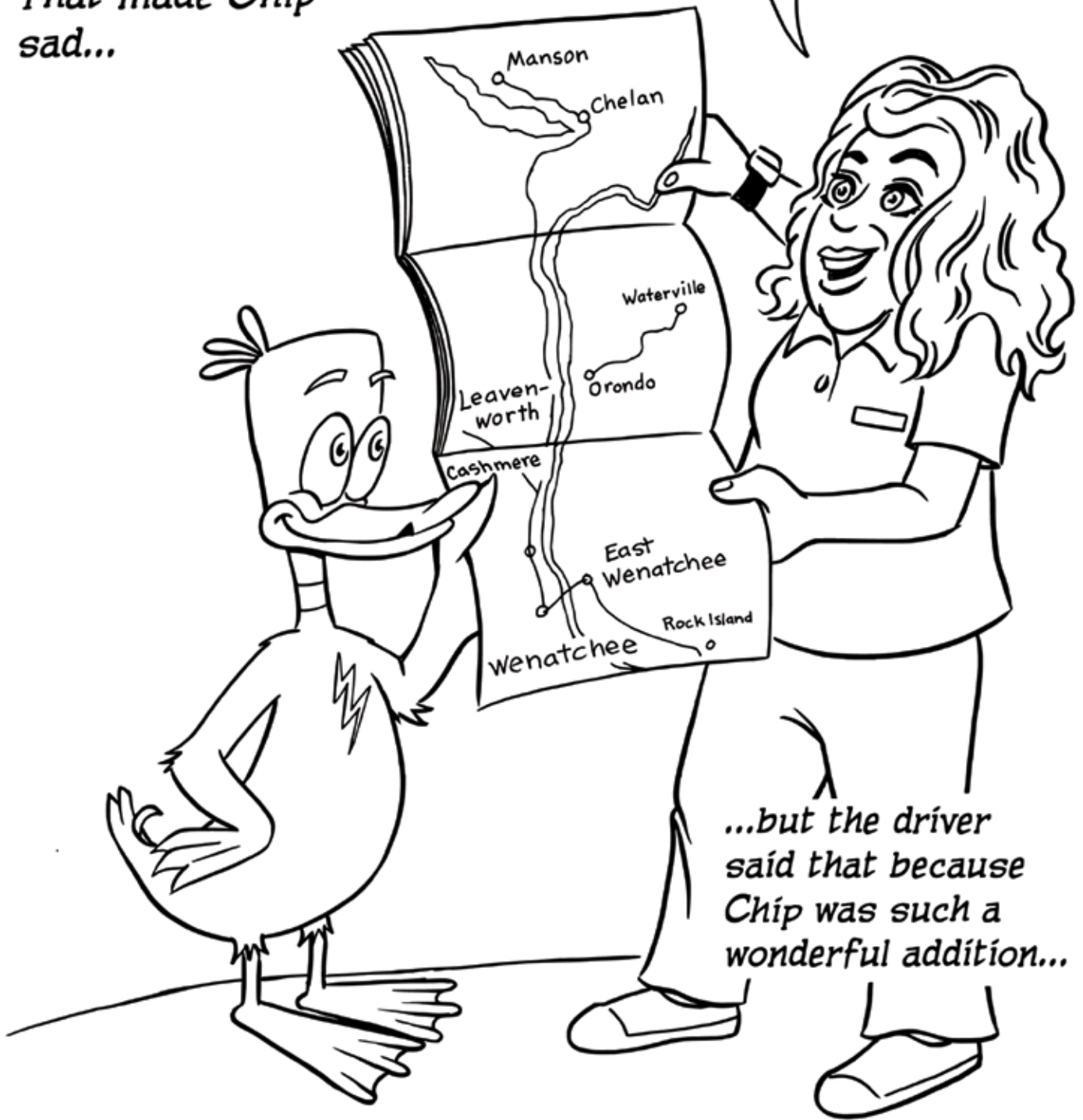
Chip thinks it's Great that Link Transit offers a wheelchair ramp to give those customers easy access to Link.

Help Chip get to each destination in the Link Transit service area.



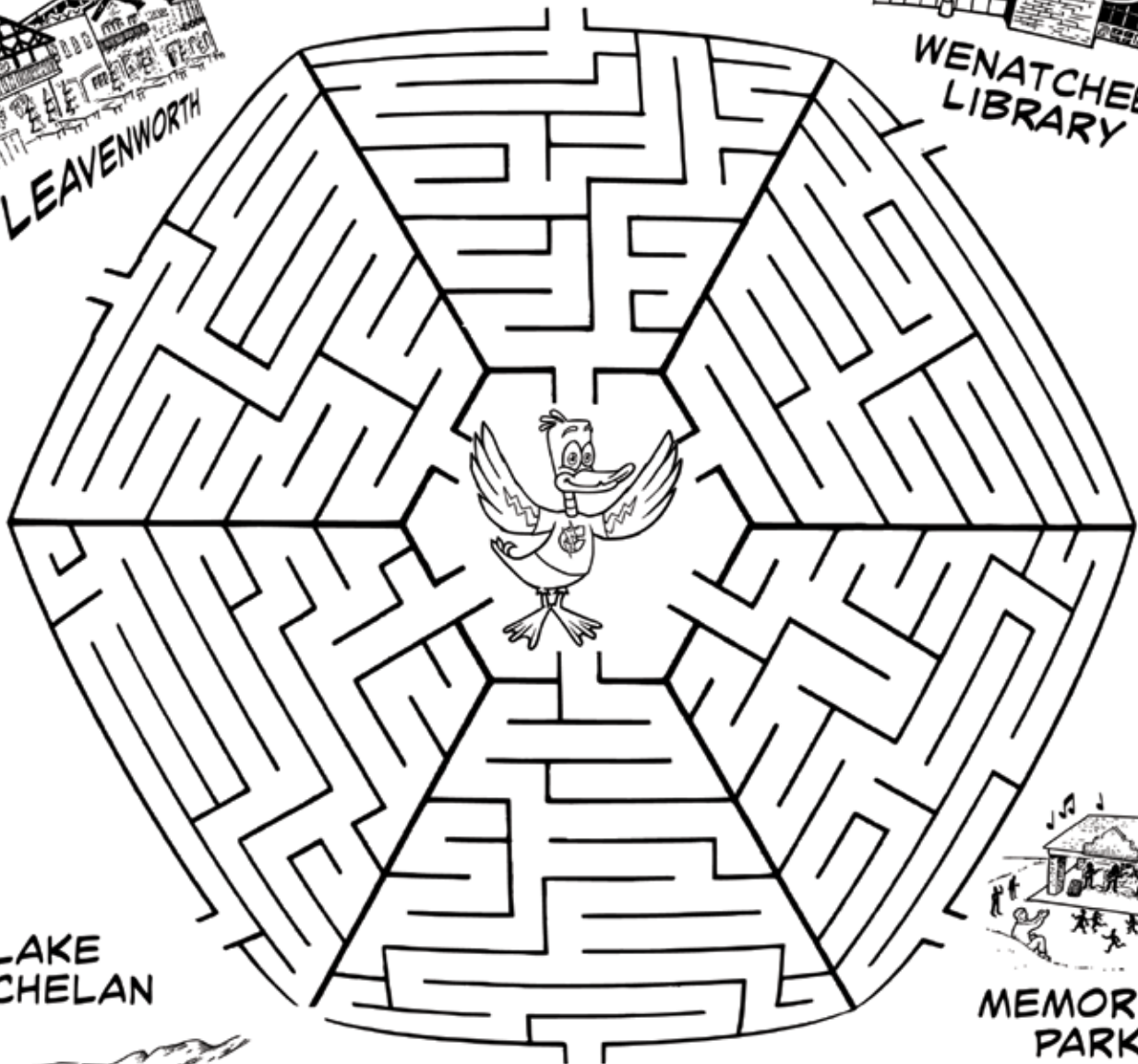

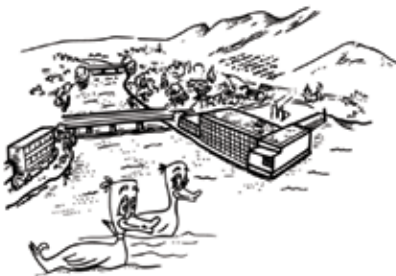
